Who is Morris Cerullo?

Known by his followers as Papa, Morris Cerullo is a Pentecostal minister, healer, and world traveler with outreach in multiple countries around the world, including Korea, India, Britain, Brazil, Nigeria, Indonesia, and many, many more. He is the President of World Evangelism, Inc., and author of over 200 books; trainer to over 5 million Christian leaders.

Design and Redesign

The current architectural team of Gordon Carrier and team from Carrier Johnson + Culture truly re-envisioned the original project in scope, approach, and inspiration. Originally designed with Roman architectural influences spanning a range of 532,000 SF, the current design team eliminated 200,000 SF and included modern design elements, making the buildings look contemporary, clean, and welcoming to all passersby while creating a place and vision that inspired meditation on the principles Cerullo teaches.

The redesign was due to the city's environmental impact report and concerns about traffic congestion among other issues. The traffic concern has been resolved by adding a lane to Hotel Circle South across the entire project length. Cerullo must maintain a count of vehicles that enter the facility's driveway over the first 3 years.

Traffic concerns and solution Cerullo's response to the city's concerns has been well received and with Carrier Johnson + Culture's approach, the project will be the timeless resort that welcomes visitors to immerse the culture around the grounds and leave their troubles at the door.

Construction features

Each building features deep foundations, cast-in-place concrete, and metal panel canopy and plaster. The vision center and museum features mechanically fastened stone and structural glazing while the pavilion features concrete on metal deck, curtain wall and adhered stone. In addition to the landscaping and buildings, there is a 4-floor 418-stall parking garage which will hold the central utility plant.

Anticipated opening

The \$160 million project is set to open to the public late 2019, early 2020.

Ives has a broad background in construction contract scenarios including design-build, GMP and hard bid.

After completion of his Bachelors in 2004, he started working in India as an architect and design manager. During that time. he was very interested in managing the projects on the site which led him to pursue his Master's degree in the United States. After finishing his Masters. Venu was offered an opportunity to work at Douglas E. Barnhart, Inc. as an estimator in San Diego and started attending the ASPE monthly chapter meetings.

The focus of the company during his tenure was on university, K-12, college and university, types of projects, small to large. Design Bid Build, CM at Risk, and Design Build. He worked with ten different estimators, management staff, and field management teams. Venu was employed by Balfour Beatty Construction for over six years and gained invaluable experience as an estimator. He then wanted to expand his knowledge of estimating, and was motivated to pursue professional certifications like CPE and DBIA to move forward in his career.

He and Paul Chang teamed together with Lou Farallo, Certification Committee Chair in 2012. and completed the technical paper and passed the GEK and DST tests. Venu was able to achieve his DBIA certification as well. At Balfour Beatty, Venu worked on complex Design-Build projects like the San Francisco State University Library Renovation, Lead Platinum Wounded Warrior Campus, San Diego Women's Detention Facility. In the meantime, Venu was offered a more diversified opportunity to work on healthcare jobs (D/B Sharp Chula Vista Parking Structure, Temecula Medical Office Building) and on the Pershing Middle School. He focused on preconstruction estimating and was responsible for preparing budgets, cost estimates, and pre-bid packages for construction projects for their clients. Kitchell Contractors gave him a chance to expand his education with an MBA degree while working for their firm under a work-study program. Currently, Venu works at Kitchell as an Estimator in the San Diego office. His focus includes education projects at San Diego State University. University of San Diego. UC Irvine (Central Plant) as well as OSHPD healthcare projects for Scripps Health and Sharp Healthcare. He is responsible for both conceptual estimates and detailed estimates, preparing GMP proposals, and buying out the new projects for their project teams.

As an Estimator, Venu is always looking for ways to provide best value to track and explore the benefits of each idea. Venu is married to his wife of six years, and they have a young boy and are expecting a second child. Outside of work, Venu enjoys time with his family and his hobbies, including touring places, camping and cooking. Venu has been an active member of the American Society of Professional Estimators (ASPE) since 2008, and he is currently serving on the ASPE Board as a Director.



I have completed numerous certificate programs: Program Estimating, Construction Practices, Construction Supervisory Technologies, Construction Supervisory Project Management. I had passed the Estimating Proficiency II Exam, endorsed by the ASPE. For me to advance in my career, my immediate supervisor encouraged me to become a CPE. With this credential, I was promoted to a Chief Estimator for Kaiser Permanente San Diego Service Delivery Team.

3 Steps to Annual Renewal

Step I = PDUs

Professional Development Units must be earned + logged within the calendar year. Submit documentation, in PDF or DOC format, to back-up journal entry.

CPE = 24 PDUs AEP = 12 PDUs

To access the PDU Journal, sign into your ASPE Profile. PDU Reference Table found on the Certification page. **CPE** = Certification > CPE Applications + Forms > More Information **AEP** = Certification > Certification Program (AEP) > More Information

Step 2 = Application

Certificate holders are required to complete the Renewal Application from within their profile.

Step 3 = Fees

Renewal Fees are paid within the online application, available at ASPEnational.org / Certification.


